Re: proposed alternative to Year 11 Winmarleigh Hall trip

As part of our ongoing commitment to supporting Year 11 we shall be going to **Kingswood - Activity Centre**, on Saturday 27th April 2019. Kingswood offers a wide variety of activities including archery, zip wire, climbing and other sporting activities. We have opted for a package that allows a mixture of onsite activities, including evening activities.

The purpose of the visit is to bring staff and students together in a relaxed environment to enable them to 'recharge the batteries' and fully engage with school in readiness for the GCSE examinations which begin in May.

Students share rooms with bunk beds and we will allocate these at a later date. There is plenty to do with an outside basketball net, indoor games and common rooms with vending machines. An outline itinerary is shown overleaf, although this may be subject to change.
